Found Poem

One of the ways to understand the tone or mood of a piece of literature is to use words from the literature to create an original poem. To create a Found Poem, you will select and combine memorable words and phrases from a text to create or "find" a poem.

Directions:

1. Look through Elie Wiesel's novel *Night* and take note (write down or use post-its) of words or phrases you find interesting or moving.
2. Use these words to create an original poem - combine words and phrases.
3. Be creative with your form. Keep in mind the tone of the novel!
4. Your poem must be at least 10 lines and must relate to the topic of the novel (the Holocaust).
5. You must present your poem in an artistic way. Use an 8 ½ x 11 piece of paper with images surrounding the poem. USE COLOR!
6. Be sure to write your name on your poem (an artist should always sign their work!)
7. **** BE CREATIVE!! ****
