One of the ways to understand the tone or mood of a piece of literature is to use words from the literature to create an original poem. To create a Found Poem, you will select and combine memorable words and phrases from a text to create or "find" a poem.

Directions:

- 1. Look through Elie Weiselts novel and take note (write down or use post-its) of words or phrases you find interesting or moving.
- 2. Use these words to create an original poem combine words and phrases.
- 3. Be creative with your form. Keep in mind the tone of the novel!
- 4. Your poem must be at least 10 lines and must relate to the topic of the novel (the Holocaust).
- 5. You must present your poem in an artistic way. Use an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 piece of paper with images surrounding the poem. USE COLOR!
- 6. Be sure to write your name on your poem (an artist should always sign their work!)
- 7. **** BE CREATIVE!! ****
