Possible Essay Questions – *Night*

- 1. Support or contradict the following statement about Elie Wiesel based on *Night*. Be sure to use at least three pieces of evidence from the book to support your view: *Eliezer probably would not have survived life in the camps if he had been alone, without his father*.
- 2. Do you agree with the characterization of *Night* as "a slim volume of terrifying power" (*New York Times*, cover blurb)?
- 3. Support or contradict the following statement: In *Night*, Elie Wiesel describes his own loss of faith.
- 4. Compare and contrast Wiesel's relationship with his father to another father/son relationship mentioned in the book, such as Rabbi Eliahou and his son.
- 5. One of the most tragic themes in *Night* is Eliezer's discovery of the way that atrocities and cruel treatment can make good people into brutes. Does he himself escape this fate?
- 6. Does Wiesel suggest any rationale behind the Holocaust in *Night*? Does he speculate as to the motives of the perpetrators? What, for Wiesel, are those motives, if they exist?
